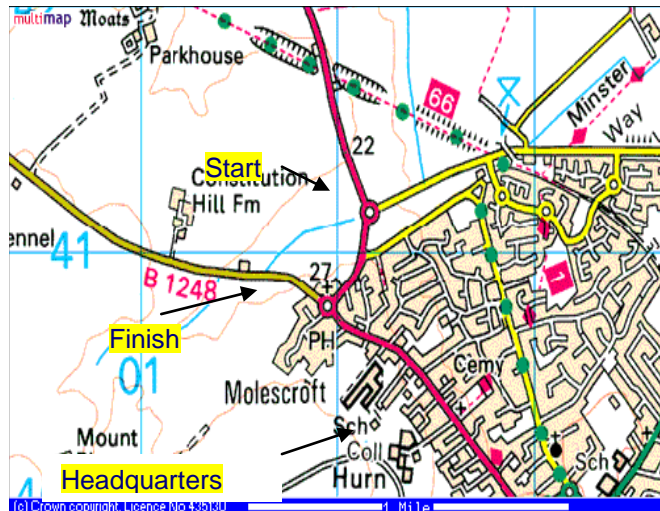


## HARDRIDERS CIRCUIT - V733/24

Start in first gateway on A164 300yards north of Beverley Eastern Bypass TI. Proceed along A164 via Leconfield, Hutton Cranswick to turn left (M) at Driffield TI with A164/A163. Proceed turn left at Bainton TI (M) continue on A163 through Bainton village & left (M) at slip road to B1248 direction Beverley. Continue on B1248 via Dog Kennel road TI (M) to finish at drain three yards before molescroft signpost approx 100 yards north of Molescroft TI at junction of B1248/A164.



**EVENT HEADQUARTERS.**  
Longcroft upper school which is situated on Burton Road, Molescroft. Access is off A164 Molescroft to Beverley road. There is ample parking and changing rooms that are quite close to the start and finish areas. Results board and refreshments will be at the headquarters.

Sign on at event headquarters and pick up your numbers. Please return your number immediately after the event in exchange for some refreshments.

### **GEORGE ELY**

George Ely was a life member of Hull Thursday road club. He joined the club in 1931 and became a national cycling star. In 1933 George won 9 consecutive open and club Time Trials and he went on to break and set many course records. George died in April 2006 and it was his family's request that an event be held in his memory. George was known for liking longer distance or hard courses and I am sure he would feel honored to have this event carry his name. I would like to thank the Ely family for their generous donation, which has increased the prize list for this year and the coming years.
